A compliance plan

I. Show Rules without exception

A. Registration: All entries must be registered between 10AM - 7PM on Thursday, March 26, 2009. No entry will be accepted afterwards. If any entry is found to be out of compliance with the rules, the exhibitor will be notified if possible. If there is time to remedy the entry before close of the hall on Thursday night, the exhibitor will be allowed to do so. If not, the entry will be disqualified from judging.

B. Each plant or flower must be tagged with correct identity and parentage.

C. Diseased or insect infected plants must not be submitted.

D. Each entry may not be removed from the space assigned to it without the consent of the Show Chair, or designated representative.

E. All entries/exhibits must be removed from exhibit hall at 4PM of the final day.

F. All entrants must read the handout *Rules & Regulations of the 37<sup>th</sup> Annual Orchid Show* and sign a statement of compliance.
