**NOS - Hobby Card Table Exhibits - 2010**  
**Class T**  
**Guidelines and Regulations**

1. Open to Society Members only. Class will be awarded for First, Second and Third Place.
  2. Exhibitors to furnish their own Card Tables and backgrounds. NOS will furnish 40” x 40” platforms.
  3. Size: 40” wide x 40” deep x 80” high maximum. Accessories and plant material may not extend beyond these dimensions.
  4. NOS will furnish sheet moss for Hobby exhibits only. NOS will furnish foliage plants for display area side borders only. Limited additional foliage may be available upon advanced request. Please confirm with show chairman when exhibit application is made.
  5. Borrowed plants may be used in any exhibit. Awards won by individual plants, if any, must go to the owners.
  6. All Plants must be correctly and prominently labeled.
  7. Wood, stone, metal, ceramic and glass accessories are permitted.
  8. The following materials are **not permitted** in container exhibits: No cut flowers; No artificial or dyed plant material; No water displays; No flowering plants other than orchids; No electric lights or other features.
  9. Name your exhibit! Please submit your Exhibit Title with your Exhibit Entry on Thursday, March 18<sup>th</sup>. Exhibit Title should be displayed. Exhibitors name should be displayed only after judging is completed.
  10. All exhibitors are asked to be familiar with the general show and exhibition rules as published in the 2010 NOS Show Schedule. All general and NOS rules will apply to all exhibit and plant entries.
- ★ Precaution will be taken for the safety of plants and accessories, however, the society will not be responsible for damage or loss.

**CARD TABLE EXHIBIT ENTRY**

- A. All Exhibits must be registered by the entry clerk at the Church Hall on Thursday, March 18<sup>th</sup> between 10:00 AM and 7:00PM. **Absolutely no entries after 7:00PM.** All entries must remain in place for the duration of the show.
- B. **Entry Chairman must be notified if any entry is removed for the space entered!**
